Salvation/Deliverance Is From Our Creator/Redeemer

The saved individual, who is born again by the Spirit of Christ, WILL be sanctified by God His Savior, and God WILL complete the good work in him, the true believer. It's simply what God does for all His children. Phil 1:6, 2:13, 1Th 2:13, 5:23-24

There is an unavoidable continuity in the life of the true believer. A changed heart lives a changed life, otherwise the heart hasn't been changed by God.

The Lord and His plan for saving, and delivering, mankind can be seen in His roles as Creator and Redeemer.

God's plan of salvation, and the fullness of the Gospel, calls on man to repent towards God, and trust in Christ to be saved, which again is two sides of the same coin.

Acknowledging God as Creator, and then as Redeemer, is a wonderful analog of repentance and faith. Acts 20:21

Repentance & Faith

This is also how we live the spiritual life, after our day of salvation. This is how we are saved and sanctified in our daily lives, living in the Gospel reality, by repentance and faith towards our Creator and Redeemer.

The very act of living in the Gospel reality, that I am saved and already victorious in Christ; that is the very means of sanctification.

But when we remember life is temporary, we acknowledge the pure gift that "life" is, and we see the big picture, of which we are a very small part.

We can take advantage of today and live it for Him, as long as it is today, because it may be our last, and we will be face to face with the Lord very soon, each and every one of us.

You are a child of God, and you do not belong here, not for long. So live the Gospel reality to which you were called, live saved and victorious, do good to all men, and swing freely in the game of life, one day at a time. You are already

victorious, being in Christ! Live like it!

Salvation is the story of the Creator and Redeemer, and what He's done for us sinners.

Understanding God as your Creator can do many things, before and after your day of salvation. It leads to a proper perspective of fear of God, as He is sovereign. As King of the universe He can do as He pleases, and that should give every man pause, that he is not in control of his life, whatsoever. Living in the Gospel reality, being saved every day, includes this attitude of repentance and humility. Being sanctified includes this as well. In fact, they are unified.

One of the little religions that fear of God can help cast out for us is sexual idolatry. We should not be foolish and think there are not consequences for rejecting God in this matter.

"and that in this matter (sexual immorality) no one should wrong his brother or take advantage of him. The Lord will punish men for all such sins, as we have already told you and warned you."
