Predestination Prototype

Jesus Christ was predestined to suffer undeservedly (Act 4:27-28).

Predestined to Suffer

Jesus' suffering was a blessing to Him ("who for the joy set before Him endured the Cross" - Heb 12:2). We believers are called the same way, to suffer for Christ's sake (e.g.: for the Gospel)("For to you it has been granted [charizomai - suffering is a grace gift] for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake" - Php 1:29).

Grace

You were PREDESTINED to suffer for Christ's sake!

Grace

You were PREDESTINED to prosper for Christ's sake, only the prosperity emphasized in the Bible is eternally weighted (**Pr 16:11; Jn 4:36-38; Ro 6:20-22; 1Ti 6:6-21; Rev 3:18-21**).

The True "Prosperity Gospel"

The false doctrine that God prospers with worldly riches as a reward for righteousness is really a slippery perversion of Truth. Prosperity is not measured in worldly riches; rather, eternal wealth. Besides, both unrighteous and righteous receive worldly prosperity.

Scale of Values

Parable of the 10 Minas

- Who originally owns the minas?
- · What do the minas represent?
- What is the purpose of "doing business"?
- What is the nature of the rewards for His stewards?

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Evaluation Under God's Scale of Values

Ask yourselves...exactly WHAT will be evaluated???...the fact that you amassed material wealth or that you amassed spiritual/eternal wealth (e.g.: shared the mind of Christ, evangelized, witnessed, etc.)? Which is the cause for reward by God? (1Co 3:12-14)

Authority Represents Responsibility

Position is merely a functional lever within an established organization; a link in the chain of command. Godly servants focus on responsibility; whereas, ungodly servants (if given the chance) focus on position.

"more shall be given"

the critical question is - more of what? If you think it's worldly prosperity, you are sadly mistaken; "more" refers to grace on God's pristine scale of values, not man's.

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Pr 16:11

A just balance and scales belong to the LORD; All the weights of the bag are His concern.

Pr 16:11 [Amplified]

A just balance and [honest] scales are the Lord's; all the weights of the bag are His concern [established by His eternal principles].

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Grace-Orientation

Is your purpose for working hard so that you can benefit, or others? But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? (1Jn 3:17).

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Grace Life In Christ

Living the Gospel reality (ala **Ro 1:16-17**) means living in eternal life, from the time you are saved on.
