The Value of True Faith

Faith is the only way to understand the supernatural things of God.

Jas 4:5-6 [Message]

You're cheating on God. If all you want is your own way, flirting with the world every chance you get, you end up enemies of God and his way. And do you suppose God doesn't care? The proverb has it that "he's a fiercely jealous lover." And what he gives in love is far better than anything else you'll find. It's common knowledge that "God goes against the willful proud; God gives grace to the willing humble."

The Value of True Faith

We aren't stressing out about "how to become" sanctified...we simple rest assured that He already HAS sanctified us! That is the key issue with faith. Faith and sanctification are so intrinsically bound, we might loosely think of them as almost "the same".

"sanctified by faith"

reveals the nature of our sanctification; at salvation it is "by grace...through faith" (Eph 2:8-9), which sets the pattern for sanctification ("from faith (positional) to faith (experiential)" - Ro 1:17).

True Faith

What's the difference between a watered down gospel and the full Gospel? The prior insufficiently presents the problem statement, which lacks the substance for consequence. The true Gospel is meant to stir up humility, if it is indeed present.

We aren't stressing out about "how to become" sanctified...we simple rest assured that He already HAS sanctified us! That is the key issue with faith. Faith and sanctification are so intrinsically bound, we might loosely think of them as almost "the same".

Gratitude

The easiest way to live a life of faith and sanctification is to fix our hope on Him...and be grateful for His love (the same love that hung on the Cross).

1Pe 1:9 [Message]

You never saw him, yet you love him. You still don't see him, yet you trust him-with laughter and singing. Because you kept on believing, you'll get what you're looking forward to: total salvation.

Salvation Perspectives

God's Perspective

Salvation from sin

Man's Perspective ("tenses")

- Positional (from penalty of sin)
- Experiential (from power of sin)
- Ultimate (from presence of sin)

Sanctification Perspectives

God's Perspective

Sanctified (set apart for Him)

Man's Perspective ("phases")

- Positional (imputed R+ / judicially)
- Experiential (imparted R+ / daily)
- Ultimate (completed R+ / eternally)
