Deception is always lurking...

If you get tied up in the details of life (e.g.: the election), you've opened the door to mass confusion in your soul!

An Unfair Fight

Satan is a super genius. You are not. If you think you can defeat him in your flesh, you are sadly mistaken. He will crush your spirit before you even realize what happened. The ONLY way to defeat ("resist") him is through the power of God (the Word and the Spirit).

An Unfair Fight

If Satan's a genius, do you really think he's so STUPID to try to pick a fight with you on God's terms??? Do you really think he's going to advertise what he's doing in your life??? Do you really think he's going to announce his strategy to you???

Perspective Requires Clarity

If you're vision is clouded by anxiety, the details of life, or the wrong priorities, you won't be able to see things for what they truly are. If you are handicapped this way, it's easy for your enemies to lead you astray. (Ps 119:105)

Perspective Requires Clarity

Being humble before His Word will light our path, period. We can count on that/ Him.

John 10:10

Perspective Requires Clarity

Your enemies aren't interested in stealing your personal belongings, or even something as temporal as the presidency of the United States. They are interested in stealing your peace so that you are too debilitated to spread the Gospel! If we as believers are here to obey our Lord's Great Commission, and we can actually have a part in SAVING OTHERS FOR ALL ETERNITY, wouldn't that be Satan's target, to take away your peace so you "can't" march forward as a good soldier of Christ Jesus?

The Spirit's been trying to open your eyes to the whole truth about your life. He's telling you to drop any vestiges of the self-life you might be clinging to, to stop fellowshipping with the world, and to quit playing games.

The Little Things (Lk 16, 19)

It's often easier to walk in the general direction of goodness and be unkempt, spiritually. It's analogous to a person who is able to keep a job, but shows up consistently hung over, filthy, etc.

A "Professional" Christian

Professionals care about the little things; in fact that's what makes them good professionals, in any field. That's what makes a "good soldier" for Christ, 2Tim 2:3-4.

A "Professional" Christian

A good Christian soldier is a professional soldier, who is humble and obedient, who pays attention to the little things, because he fears and respects the Lord.

2 Tim 2:3-4 The Message

When the going gets rough, take it on the chin with the rest of us, the way Jesus did. A soldier on duty doesn't get caught up in making deals at the marketplace. He concentrates on carrying out orders.

The Little Things

You might ask, "Why does the Lord care about all the 'little things'?"

The Little Things

Simple...it's because He understands the erosive nature of our enemies. They tempt us to leave this or that small detail for later, to give in to worldly pressure, to intoxicate ourselves to numb the convicting ministry of the Spirit while doing so...

The Little Things (cont.)

...and before we know it, all the little things, and all the micro-adjustments away from God's will for us, and all the steps we've taken in a perverted direction, add up to our being way off course!

Spiritual reality

What one believes in their heart inevitably appears in their life, whether good or bad.

And stay focused on the little things, being a good soldier for Christ, because it may well be those little things that your friends see in you that turns them to Christ and His love.
